

## **Joyce Snyder Art Exhibit**

The Patterson Inn exhibit room was the site of the opening reception Sunday, February 7, 2:00-4:00 of the art of Joyce Snyder. Joyce was a local artist who did drawings of many landmarks, public buildings, and homes in the Corning-Painted Post area for about 35 years. She did “pet portraits”, watercolors, and oils as well. The buildings and homes are pen and ink. The artworks are cherished by their owners, as they are literally taking the pictures off their walls to bring in for the exhibit! The exhibit was up until May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2010. The reception was attended by close to one hundred people.

We displayed 50 artworks done by Joyce. Most were buildings done in pen and ink. There were a couple of watercolors of houses, and a lovely set of four matching watercolors of a woodland garden. We had five drawings of the Patterson Inn from different eras, as the house went through several changes architecturally. There were drawings of the Browntown School, the Wixon Road Log Cabin, the Painted Post Indian Monument, and other landmarks in downtown Corning on exhibit. Many of our members loaned drawings of their pets (done in pastels) or homes for the exhibit.
